Qualifications for CSE: 1st Class M.E. / M.Tech in CSE / I.T with B.E. / B.Tech in CSE / I.T.

Qualifications for ECE: EEE; Mechanical Engg; Civil Engg., and Chemical Engineering:

First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate Branch of Engineering / Technology

OR

First Class Bachelor's degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering / Technology or equivalent with valid GATE score, minimum 75 percentile. Such candidates have to complete M.Tech / M.E. within 5 years failing which the increments will be stopped until the postgraduate degree is earned.

Qualifications for Assistant Professor in MCA:

First Class MCA Degree / M.Sc., (Computer Science) / M.Sc., (Information Technology) with NET Qualification.

OR

First Class B.E / B. Tech in Computer Science / Information Technology / Engineering / Technology with GATE Qualification of minimum 80 % percentile score.

Qualifications for Assistant Professor in Bio-technology:

First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) / Technology (Tech.)

OR

First Class Bachelor's degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering / Technology.

OR


Ph D in Applied Biological Sciences such as Microbiology, Genetics, Molecular Biology, Pharmacy, Biophysics

For Assistant Professors in English & Chemistry:

Good academic record with 1st class at M.Sc., level (for Science) or at M.A. Level (for Humanities). Preference shall be given to Ph. Degree holders.

OR

Good academic record with atleast 55% marks or, an equivalent CGPA at the Master's Degree level, in the relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from a Foreign University. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for Assistant Professors conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC.
