CIRCULAR

Google Summer of Code (GSoC) is a prestigious online global program focused on engaging new contributors in open-source software development. GSoC contributors collaborate with open-source organizations on a real world programming project spanning over the course of 12 weeks or more, under the guidance of experienced mentors. The program is highly esteemed within the professional community and contributors are awarded a stipend with a starting price of 1500 USD ranging up to 6600 USD. Furthermore, the program is open to all students with a major prerequisite being a passion to contribute to open-source culture.

To disseminate awareness among the student community, the CBIT Open Source Community (COSC), in collaboration with the Career Development Center (CDC), is organizing an awareness session on GSoC. Interested students from all years (I, II, III, and IV) and from all branches are encouraged to attend the session. The session's attendance will be taken and submitted to the respective departments.
