j. Add content in p.no.9 (below *CIE: Continuous Internal Evaluation (Max. Marks: 40)

Out of 40 CIE marks:

- 1) 20 marks are based on the average of two Internal Tests/Mid-Term Examinations (weightage for each test is 20 marks of one hour duration). The question paper for internal tests will be in two parts, Part-A and Part-B. Part A is for three (3) questions and is compulsory, and carries six (6) marks. Part-B carries fourteen (14) marks, student has to answer two questions among three questions and each question carries seven (7) marks.
- 2) 10 marks are allotted for Assignment(s). Assignment methods can be opted as per the scope of the course. There are two methods:
 - a) Case Studies/Book Review/Relevant Industry visit & Report/ Course end project/ Open ended problem, student has to submit one assignment consisting of 10 marks; or
 - b) Two Assignments (should be from BL4 and BL5), average of two assignments, each of 10 marks.
- 3) Three slip tests (5 marks each) shall be conducted and average of the best two slip tests will be considered.
- 4) Attendance percentage carries marks as mentioned in CIE table (Maximum 5 marks).

****Semester End Examination (SEE) (Max. Marks: 60) last para , deletion.**

For non-credit courses also the minimum pass mark is 40% and the students who secures more than are equal to 40% of maximum mark, then the student will be awarded with 'Satisfactory' otherwise they will be awarded with 'Not-satisfactory'.
