Minutes:

ITEM 1: To confirm the minutes of Second Academic Council meeting

The minutes of Second meeting of academic council held on 19-03-2014 are confirmed.

ITEM 2: To approve the syllabus for 2/4 B.E/B.Tech of all branches

CIVIL: It is recommended to award only one credit instead of two(2) credits, for Surveying Camp and also to include description in detail.

CSE: It is recommended to:

1. CS 225 - Change of course title "Microprocessors" suitably to map the course contents and swapping of units IV and V
2. CS 227 - Change of course title "Microprocessors Lab" suitably to map the course contents.
3. Include Suggested Reading for all Lab Courses.

EEE: It is recommended to include "Solid Mechanics" in II-semester and offer "Managerial Economics and Accountancy" in 3/4 II - semester

IT: It is recommended to rename "Discrete Mathematics" as "Discrete Structures"

CHEMICAL: It is recommended to:

1. Frame the Syllabus for "Mechanical and Electrical Engineering Lab" by Chairmen BoS of both Mechanical Engg and EEE.
2. Change the title of the subject CH 221 Fluid Mechanics appropriately.

MATHEMATICS: It is recommended to change of course title of Mathematics subjects for 2/4 B.Tech -Biotechnology suitably, in both the semesters

ENGLISH:

1. "Soft Skills for Employability" with two Contact periods per week, and is recommended to offer this course for all other branches of B.E/B.Tech either in 2/4-II Semester or 3/4-I-Semester . Also recommended to include an exercise or part of exercise on "Academic Ethics".
2. The elective course on "Technical Writing" is approved. This elective may be offered in 3/4 II Semester or 4/4 I-semester

The council approved the syllabus for 2/4 B.E/B.Tech with the above recommendations.

ITEM 3: To approve the syllabus for 2/3 MCA and 2/2 MBA

MCA: It is recommended to:

1. MC 215 - To change the title and contents suitably
2. MC 226 - Elaborate description is recommended

MBA: It is recommended to:

1. MB 261 - Instruction is for 4 lecture periods
2. To prepare 2/2 II -semester syllabus

The council approved the syllabus for 2/3 MCA and 2/2 MBA with the above recommendations.

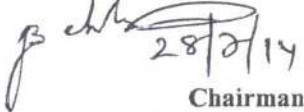

2. It is decided to have the following to all branches of B.E/B.Tech:
 - 4/4 - I Semester : Project Seminar for 3(three) periods with 1(One) Credit
 - 4/4 - II Semester : Project for 6(Six) periods with 9(nine) Credits
3. BoS Chairman (ECE) presented a new elective course namely "Strategic Electronics" for M.E (Comm. Engg) programme and is approved.
4. It was resolved to propose a student need-based flexible special course on advanced topics for M.E students of Mech Engg Dept. as an elective.
5. **It was resolved to number all the course objectives and course outcomes (Maximum: FOUR).**
6. Four(4) credits are allotted for " Project Seminar" in 3rd Semester and Sixteen(16) credits for "Dissertation" in 4th Semester for M.E/M.Tech.
7. BoS Chairman (CIVIL) presented M.E (Structural Engg.) syllabus and the council suggested to change the title "Neural , Fuzzy and Expert Systems" suitably.
8. **Include course objectives and course outcomes wherever not indicated**
9. It was resolved to follow a standard format, as given below, for mentioning the text books and suggested reading.
