The institute has received a grant of Rs7, 00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh only) Under EDC Scheme for the financial year 2005-2006 from AICTE with the F.No.: 8023/RID/BOIII-EDC/12/2005-2006 dated: 09-Jan-2006.

As part of this several entrepreneurship awareness camps, seminars, guest lectures, conferences and faculty development programmes etc. were organized. Entrepreneurship is being offered as an elective subject for B.E Final year (All branches). Institute has also organized one year Technology Entrepreneurship Programme for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year students in collaboration with ISB, Hyderabad and AP Society for Knowledge Networks. 
