



EWB-CBIT

Engineers Without Borders (EWB) was founded by Prof.Bernard Amadei in USA. EWB-India was established in the year 2005 with a motto to involve engineers and other professionals in a movement of constructive change. Today, a total of 9 professional chapters were established across India and 75 student chapters come under these professional chapters.

EWB-CBIT was started in the year 2015 by Dr. Shaukat Mirza with a vision "To nurture and motivate students and professionals to undertake real life sustainable social projects and create global leaders".

The projects taken up by EWB-CBIT are

1. Rain water Harvesting

Two Rain water Harvesting pits were dug in the college to harvest the rain water and use it.

2. Sewage water treatment

In the Research and Development Building of DRDE, sewage is collected and is treated with bacteria. The treated water is passed through a compartment and fresh water is collected.

3. E-learning Centers

With the assistance from EWB-INDIA, three E-classrooms were installed at

- 1. Central Upper Primary School, Khanapur
- 2. Z.P.H.S, Hydershahkota
- 3. Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV), Kishmathpur.





4. Solar Electrification:

In Kastrurba Gandhi Balika Vidyalava(KGBV) Kismathpur, we installed solar panels.

5. Bio Compost:

In CBIT, using vegetable and fruit waste from canteen as a substrate, bio-compost was prepared using lactobacillus.

6. Paper Recycling:

With an aim to reduce the wastage of paper, we have collected old books from our college. We collaborated with an NGO "YUVATHA" and recycled the old books collected and distributed them to the children studying in government schools.

7. Sampurna E-Vidya App:

To provide children from government schools access to all educational resources, we approached EWB-INDIA to develop an app named "Sampurna E-Vidya" app.

The camps and awareness programs conducted by EWB-CBIT are

1 .Plastic awareness camps:

We conducted a plastic awareness camp in KGBV school.



2. Career Guidance:

Every year, we will conduct a career guidance program for the children studying in government schools. This year, we conducted it online for our college students regarding various career oppurtunities available after their graduation.







3. Gnanotsav:

In 2018, we conducted project expo, quiz and interactive sessions for 200 higher secondary students.





4. Impact Podcast:

Every week, we will release a podcast regarding any person who did phenomenonal work an is less known in society.

5. Education camps:

Due to the Covid-19, many government school children do not had any classes. So, we conducted online classes to the children studying in various govt.schools during weekends.

In Vasanth Nagar School, kukatpally, there was a problem with lack of faculty. So, during weekends, we taught maths and English to the students for six months.



6. E-Ankuram

In January 2019, we conducted E-Ankuram event. It consists of Quiz, elocution, debate and essay writing competition to the children from government schools.









7. Best out of waste:

In February 2019, an event was taken up by EWB-CBIT to make decorative items from the waste produced at home.

8. Cloth to Cloth Bags:

In October 2019, to reduce the wastage of clothes, we collected old clothes from members and colloborated with an NGO "Nirmaan" and stitched cloth bags with them and distributed to the staff, students of our college.







9. Mathemagicians

On December 22nd 2019, we conducted quiz, elocution and essay writing competitions to the students in 8 different government schools on the eve of Sri Ramanujan's birthday.



Activities taken during the pandemic COVID-19

During April, May-2020, we distributed groceries, masks and cooked food packets to the migrant workers, daily labour who were affected with the lockdown. With an estimated cost of Rs. 1,06,500, we distributed essentials to around 135 families and 870 individuals.


We,The team EWB-CBIT are so happy to share the event which we have done named "THROUGH THE PERPLEXITY..."
