In the 8th Meeting of BoS (Civil Egg) held on 11-03-2017 at 10:00AM in the conference hall, a thorough discussion was held on the proposed scheme of instruction of 2/4,3/4 & 4/4 BE (Civil) and the board made the following recommendations for implementation

- 1. To retain Engineering Geology, Concrete Technology and Water Resources Engineering II as they are, in view of their importance and occurrence only once in the curriculum (Engineering Geology and Concrete Technology) and growing significance in respect of Water Resource Engineering respectively.
- 2. To remove steel Structures II from the core Subjects of proposed scheme and include it in electives.
- 3. To prepare the syllabus of Surveying subject (Combining Survey I & II), Sri.S.S.V.Chalam, Professor was assigned this task in view his enormous experience in teaching that subject
- 4. To name the subject consisting of Building Materials, Construction & Planning as "Building Planning, Materials & Construction". It was suggested that building Bye-Laws & Provisions of National Building Code to be included in the syllabus of the above mentioned subjects.
- 5. To make a thorough spell check of the syllabi & provide the latest editions of books in the references & Suggested readings.
- 6. It was also approved to include two new units on "Yield Line Analysis of Reinforced Concrete Slabs and Non-Linear Analysis of Reinforced Concrete Structures in structural Design in place of "Flat Slabs and Portal Frames" as these topics are already included in Advanced Reinforced Concrete Design

Having no other item, Chairman BOS, (Civil Engineering) thanked all the members for their presence & contributions.
