Item No.1: Approval of AICTE Model curriculum for English, theory & lab, for B.E 1st year

studentsall branchesfrom the academic year 2018-19

Minutes: All the members have thoroughly discussed the topics in each unitin the theory paper

and approved the designed syllabus with a few changes pertaining to the topic and unit

headings. The lab syllabus was approved without any changes.

Item No.2: Approval of the course "Gender sensitization" as open elective for B.E V and VI

semesters

Minutes: All the members of the Board of Studies have unanimously approved the course

"Gender Sensitisation" and stated that the course cannot be combined with another course or offered during the induction program. The members suggested /recommended that the said courseshould be mandatory and can be offered to III year BE/B.Tech students in the form of activities and case studies, 2/3 hours per week. It was also mentioned that the said course is being offered in JNTUH and its affiliated colleges since 2015 and that it is going to be offered by Osmania University too from 2018-19

Item No. 3: Approval of the AICTE model curriculum course "English for Research Paper

Writing " for M.Tech I/II Semester (Audit Course) from 2018 -19.

Minutes: All the members of the Board of Studies have unanimously approved of the model

curriculum course "English for Research Paper Writing" for M.Tech in the second semester as an Audit Coursefrom academic year 2018 -19. (as the faculty have

expressed that they are heavily overloaded with classwork in the 1st or odd semester)

Item No. 4: Approval of the changes in Soft Skills and Employability Enhancement course for

BE/B.Tech III&IV Semester.

Minutes: All the members of the Board of Studies have unanimously approved the existing

syllabus of Soft Skills and Employability Enhancement course for BE/B.Tech III&IV

Semesters, witha few changes.

Item No. 5: Discussion of the proposed course in AICTE Model curriculum "Essence of Indian Traditional Knowledge" for B.E. 1st Semester from 2018-19.

Minutes:

All the members of the Board of Studies have unanimously approved the AICTE model curriculum course "Essence of Indian Traditional Knowledge" for B.E. 1st Semester from 2018-19. They suggested that a detailed syllabus be designed relevant to the students of today.

Item No.6: Removal of English language lab for Bridge Course students from 2018-19.

Minutes: The members of the BOS directed the department retain the English Language Lab for Bridge Course students. Upon comparing the syllabus of the Bridge Course with the English syllabus taught in the Polytechnic college it was concluded that some essential components in Phonetics and Communication skills taught in the English language Lab are necessary as the students are weak in English.

Themembersrecommended that Bridge coursework load should be included in the total work load and the staff taking the bridge course classes shouldbe given appropriate remuneration as the classes are taken after regular college hours.

Under any other item with the permission of the Chair:

Item No. 7: Separate department of English(Represented in previous BoS too in 2013, 2016)

The Board of Studies meeting has debated and discussed at length the need of having a separate department for the faculty of English in CBIT. The members stated that the management should initiate forming a separate department English since the faculty of English are involved inmany academic activities that need independent functioning.

The faculty offer courses for BE/BTech Ist years, IInd years, MBA, MCA, and MTech students too. They organize training programs for the teaching and the, non-teaching staff in English and communication skills. The members were of the opinion that autonomy would not only lend dignityand self esteem but further strengthen the department and boost the morale of the faculty to achieve greater things. It was also noted that many Engineering colleges have a separate department for English. Therefore the members strongly recommended a separate department for English.
