- Organic Bio-compost is organic matter that has been decomposed and recycled as a fertilizer and soil amendment.
As its most essential, the process of composting requires simply piling up waste outdoors and waiting for the materials to break down from anywhere between the stipulated time period . The aim of this project is to build Green CBIT
- 28% yield was obtained from the compost
- This method of composting is to be practiced in the schools of KGBV, Kismatpur, Mailardevpally

Generally, the decayed organic material used as a fertilizer for growing plants is known as COMPOST.

To gardeners, compost is considered "black gold" because of its many benefits in the garden. Adding compost to clay soils makes them easier to work and plant. In sandy soils, the addition of compost improves the water holding capacity of the soil. By adding organic matter to the soil, compost can help improve plant growth and health. Nitrogen, potassium, and phosphorus will be produced naturally by the feeding of microorganisms.

Composting is also a good way to recycle leaves and other yard waste. Instead of paying a company to haul away leaves, you can compost the leaves and return the nutrients to your garden. Instead of buying peat moss, save money and make your own compost!

The main goal of the project is to ensure that the e-learning centers established by EWB-Hyderabad chapter in and around Hyderabad are being maintained and used efficiently. EWB Hyderabad chapter has installed many E-learning centers in various government school so as to provide students quality education and make learning process much easier. As a matter of fact anything that is installed would need proper maintenance for it to work on a longer run. The project aims at reducing the time taken to repair and proficiently use the E-learning centers which would in turn fulfill the mission of EWB-India. Additionally, we also aim at providing E-learning study material in the form of lecture and animation videos which will be beneficial for the students.

2.1.1 Project Title: “Sampurna E-Vidya App”

2.1.2 Project Summary:

In order to ensure that these e-learning centers are maintained and they are working properly we propose to develop an app.

- The app would consist of an admin login ID, a school representative login ID, and a professional chapter login ID.
- If there is any problem, the school headmaster can raise a complaint by logging into the app. This could also be done by the faculty who is dutifully responsible for the maintenance of the E-learning center.
- Initially, while registering into the app the details of the e-learning centers would be collected and a database of all required IDs will be created and maintained simultaneously so that a detailed record of the school would be available when a complaint is raised.
- Once a complaint is received, the school would be personally contacted and a mail about the same would be sent to the Hyderabad chapter.
- The location of the school would be identified and the nearest EWB-student chapter would look into visiting the school and solving the problem faced by them with the help of a professional chapter member within a week.

The schools would have to give an update on the current status of the e-learning center once in a month. In this process a complaint can be raised by the head master at any point of time regarding anything related to the E-learning center. If we do not get an update for 6 months, a field visit would be planned in order to know the reason behind it. Emphasis would be made on the need for using the e-learning centers.

- Through this app, we would also provide E-learning study material such as lecture videos and animations which are easily accessible and can be downloaded by the schools.

Many E-learning centers have been installed in past few years. These can be used to the fullest extent only when there is a proper maintenance of them. This would have a huge impact on the time taken to rectify a certain problem and thus increase the efficiency of it. In addition to this, the study of the received data would help find the unseen flaws in the procedure and thus resolve them.

FUTURE SCOPE:

If this project runs successfully, we look forward to extend it in terms of 2 aspects.

- This project could be extended to the areas such as sanitation, health and water needs of these schools.
- It could also be extended to the E-learning centers installed under other professional chapters in India.

EWB-India is expected to look into the mails which would include the details of the complainant and the financial aid necessary to help them. It is expected to provide financial support directly or indirectly for the project.

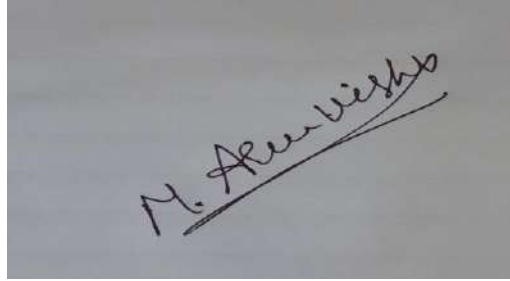

What are the Five W's and One H? They are Who, What, Why, When, Where and How. Why are the Five W's and One H important? Journalism purists will argue your story isn't complete until you answer all six questions. It's hard to argue this point, since missing any of these questions leaves a hole in your story. The concept is pretty simple, while reporting, be it a written report, audio note or video, one just has to ensure the report covers the 5 W's and 1 H about the story.

Even if you aren't a reporter, you can still use these questions to help you brainstorm for ideas and map out an outline for your content.

Below is a list of the questions and some possibilities for each. The questions provided are as general as possible in order to provide a guide that you might use for any topic. For that reason, they may seem a little strange unless you have a specific topic in mind.

Who

- Who is involved?
- Who is affected?
- Who will benefit?
- Who will be harmed?

What

- What is your topic narrowed down in a simple phrase/sentence?
- What does your topic involve? (I.e. what are the different parts in it?)

- What is it similar to / different from?
- What might be affected/changed by your topic?

When

- When does this take place? When did this take place? When will it take place?
When should this take place?
- Does when this takes place affect the topic?

Where

- Where does this take place? (Where did it Where will it ... Where should it?)
- Does it matter where it takes place? Is it affected by location? Why?
- Why is this topic important? Why does it matter?
- Why do certain things happen? (What are some causes and effects within the topic?)

How

- How does this topic work? How does it function? How does it do what it does?
- How did it come to be?
- How are those involved affected?

There is another question that I will throw in here: "What if?" What if is not a question a reporter would typically use, not in the lead paragraph anyway, but it's often an excellent question to ask for other types of situations.

What If

- What if everything worked as it should?
- What if everything didn't work as it should?
- What if this topic didn't exist?

To address the growing concern of energy and water scarcity, an idea can be proposed to paint the roofs with a white paint of high quality such as Insulated so that it reduces the temperature inside the house and lowers the current costs as well as helps in accumulating the rainwater. It has been carried out successfully in certain rural parts of Tamil Nadu as part of a research with British Council & TERI and is very doable. As the solution involves saving both current (energy) as well as helps in rainwater harvesting (water), it is a very relevant and cheaper solution in the market.

TRANSPIRATIONAL CAR ROOFTOP

It's a sunny summer day. A car will become too warm after leaving it under the sun for merely half an hour. The unbearable heat would prompt to instinctively turn on the air conditioner at full blast. And, it is only when the car temperature is more endurable that journey can be started. Later many other stops may come in the way. Thinking that it won't take long, one may decide to put the car at idle to prevent it from getting warm. One good solution lies in revolutionizing the design of car cabinet. What if the cabinet can transpire and allow heat to be carried away by evaporation of water without using any fuel or electricity, very much similar to how plant cools itself?
