One Week Faculty Development Programme on UNIVERSAL HUMAN VALUES

July 2-6th, 2018

REPORT

A one-week faculty development programme on "UNIVERSAL HUMAN VALUES" organized by the Department of Physics, Chaitanya Bharati Institute of Technology, Gandipet, Hyderabad within the campus from July 2nd to 6th, 2018, flagged off with a grand Inaugural session on 2nd July, 2018. The Principal of the Institute Dr. P. Ravinder Reddy graced the occasion and followed by the traditional lightning of the lamp, delivered a motivating speech, reminding the need & benefits of Faculty Development Programs for the faculty and recalled how the management and the various departments makes efforts in motivating the faculty to enhance in their career with the skills attained while getting trained in the FDPs. He insisted the importance of Universal Human values to be invoke in our daily and professional lives, and the need to train the students too. He appreciated and encouraged the Head of Department and Faculty of Department of Physics, to conduct many more such sessions. After the convener outlined how the FDP is planned outlining the efforts put into it, he outlined the number and the different places from which the participants registered and participated. A Keynote Address, was delivered by the Keynote Speaker Prof. Sreenivas Sarma, who elaborated the importance of Universal Human Values in the society and how teaching acts as a bridge. He stressed the role of faculty in building a values and ethics-based society. Prof. K. Krishnaveni delivered a session on "The role of UHV in technical education", where she gave the definition of value education and how it helps one to understand 'what is valuable' for human happiness. The participants were made to understand the gaps in the present educational system where

complete emphasis is on science and technology and how 'Value education' when missed to be imparted will lead to counterproductive and serious crises at the individual, societal and environmental level inspite of faculty's tiresome effort.

On 3rd July, 2018, the resource person Prof. P. Sreenivas Sarma, delivered a thought provoking and interactive session on "Need for value education Program". He introduced how value education nurtures an individual to know himself and judge himself to take decisions, overcoming curiosity. He reminded how it develops in understanding one's own interests, attitudes, values and capacities. He said that this would help a person to first rejuvenate his own personality and become a resource person to many more in the society. The need to enhance the effort by a teacher to help the student develop positive and ethical competencies in addition to supporting and framing their academic achievement by careful crafting pedagogy for each individual student according the need is high lightened in this session by the resource person. In the noon session, Dr. G. Suresh Babu spoke on "Mulya Pravah", list of guidelines and its objectives framed to inculcate ethics and values in educational system identifying the need to create high quality practices and environment backed with human values and professional ethics in Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs). He also outlined Human Values and Professional Ethics, Values and Ethics for Stakeholders, stakeholder-Wise Implementation of Human Value and Professional Ethics in Higher Educational Institutions. He suggested to encourage students to practice moral values and ethics by explaining to them examples like the cherishing values followed by our freedom fighters for independence.

On the third day of the FDP, a session on "Happiness and Basic Human Aspirations" was delivered by Prof. P. Sreenivas Sarma. He started off the session, interacting with the faculty, the definition of "Happiness" collecting their opinions, and instructed how it's related with harmony and peace. He also insisted the importance and lead of the role of one's healthy and peaceful relationship with others and society. He reminded how humans are lacking happiness by wrongly connecting it to "prosperity". He aligned the participants to come up with their understanding and examples of "prosperity", and made them understand how happiness and prosperity are the bases of all our desires and the efforts. He insisted the need to assess one need of physical facilities, else how it lead to disharmony. He also

reminded the need to learn and utilize our intelligence effectively create a physical facility and lead a happy life. He trained the teachers how to promote these in our classroom teaching and pedagogy practices. Dr. A.V.N. Rao in the noon session resourced the participants by providing his thought-provoking ideas and opinions on "Harmony". He raised the importance for a student to understand values in human relationship, so that he can recognize the connectedness with every individual correctly and it becomes easy live in harmony with every human being-thus laying the foundation for an undivided society- from family to world family.

The role of "Trust & Respect" in building a value-based society was discussed in a session delivered on the fourth day of FDP by Dr. A.V.N. Rao. He outlined how knowing and understanding one's self, and the importance of building sound relationship with people around him and the society. And lead the discussion into the definition of Trust and Respect and their importance in peaceful relationship with the society. He said that the student needs to be trained to desire to see the others happy and earn trust from them. To maintain integrity and consistency in relationships, he insisted the self-examination of any lack of competence that leads others to hurt or loss and the need of right understanding of the intention of all the human beings around us. He gave hints and strategic plan of teaching the students to make them understand how this would improve his competence in others and in himself. He also lead the group to define "respect" as 'individuality' by gathering their opinions towards its definition and to understand how the sense of individuality is prime object towards respect. "Society and Nature" and its relationship with Universal human values were discussed in the noon session by Dr. G. Suresh Babu, wherein nhe introduced different levels of society and how an individual should be matured enough to accept everyone to bring harmony and happiness for himself.

On the final day of the FDP, "Professional Ethics" were discussed by the Resource Person-Prof P. Sreenivas Sarma, CBIT, Hyderabad. He insisted that developing ethical competence in the individual (profession) is the only effective way to ensure professional ethics and said that value education acts as a resource to achieve it. He guided the participants to understand that the competence in profession will only be the manifestation of one's right understanding, with illustrations. Need of clarity about comprehensive human

goal, Confidence in oneself, Clarity and confidence in ethical human conduct and its correlation with sustained personal as well as collective happiness and prosperity in professional grounds was highlighted. In light of these, he added that one's ability to identify and develop appropriate technologies, production systems etc adhering to people and eco-friendly principles. This was followed by Valedictory function, where faculty gave their summaries of what they've learnt in the form of feedback and it ended with vote of thanks by the convenor of the programme.



Chaitanya Bharathi Institute of Technology successfully organized the Student Induction Program as per the norms of AICTE to provide an orientation to the first-year engineering students who joined the institute for the four years BE/B.Tech program. The Two-week Orientation Program followed by Student Induction Program was conducted from 28-07-2018 to 11.08.2018.

The purpose of the SIP has been to prepare the newly admitted undergraduate students for the new stage in their life by facilitating a smooth transition to the college life.

The goal of the SIP has been to help the students to:

- Become familiar with the ethos and culture of the institution i.
- Set a healthy daily routine, create bonding in batch as well as between faculty members ii. and students
- Get an exposure to a holistic vision of life, develop awareness, sensitivity and iii. understanding
- Facilitate them in creating new bonds with peers and seniors iv.
- Overcome weaknesses in some essential professional skills ٧.

As a part of the Induction program, the institute conducted all the sessions which have been made mandatory by the AICTE. The students were welcomed into the CBIT family and have been adequately inducted into the engineering course which they are going to pursue. The program has oriented the students towards the various aspects of the offered courses, curriculum, assessment and evaluation patterns, the recent changes which have been brought into them, the various avenues for exploration in terms of employment and career, the nurturing of their diverse talents through clubs and other activities, in addition to the comprehensive information and guidance about the different aspects of the institute.

The Inaugural session of the Student Induction Program was conducted on 28th July 2018 at 10:00 AM for all the first year CBIT students by lighting the lamp. Dr.P.Ravinder Reddy, Principal, CBIT gave the Welcome Address. He welcomed all the freshers and explained the vision and mission of the institute and the institute's emphasis on advanced research to generate knowledge and direct it into transformation of society.

The Directors and Joint Directors were introduced and they briefed the gathering about their respective domains. Dr.B.Linga Reddy, HoD Physics and Coordinator SIP briefed the Students about the Induction program.








Awareness on Road Safety by TTI, Gachibowli


