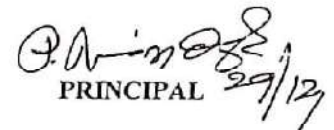

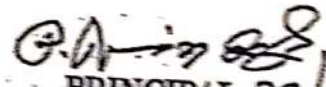

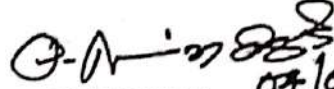

Dr. Suresh Pabboju, Chairman, Board of Studies (IT) welcomed and introduced the members of the reconstituted Board of Studies (IT). After, presenting brief introduction of the department and the Institute, the chairman conducted the proceedings.

Item 1: Confirmation of the minutes of the sixth BoS meeting held on 23-04-2017.
Minutes of previous sixth BoS meeting held on 23-04-2017 are confirmed.

Item 2: To approve the syllabus for Semesters - V and VI of B.E. (IT) program under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

The proposed syllabus for Semester - V and Semester - VI for B.E. (IT) program is approved with following minor suggestions:

- The course "Software Engineering" is moved to Semester - V from Semester - VI.
- The course "Computational Intelligence" has been renamed as "Artificial Intelligence" and is moved to Semester - VI from Semester - V.
- In "Software Engineering"
 - a. DevOps, Agile Software Development topics are to be included.
 - b. Details in Scrum and Sprint topics are to be provided.
 - c. Selenium demonstration for testing has to be added.
- A lab for "Web Technologies" is to be added
In this regard it is advised to combine Operating Systems and Web Technology labs and hence Operating Systems lab is renamed as Operating Systems and Web Technology Lab.
- Course on "Python Programming" under Elective-I should be emphasized by giving Assignments and Mini Projects in the course.

Item 3: To propose and approve the scheme of syllabus for Semesters - VII and VIII of B.E. (IT) program under CBCS.

The proposed scheme of syllabus for Semesters - VII and VIII for B.E. (IT) program is approved with following minor suggestions:

- The Course "Cloud Computing" is to be included in the Semester - VII under Elective-IV and "Natural Language Processing" is to be included in the Semester - VIII under Elective-VI.
- The Course "Virtual and Augmented Reality" is replaced with "Data Analytics using R" under Elective-V in Semester - VIII
- Course on "Business Intelligence" under Elective-VI in the Semester - VIII should emphasize on Reporting tools and ETL tools while preparing the syllabus for the next academic year.

Item 4: To suggest syllabus for Programming for Problem Solving in Semester - I of B.E. (all branches).

The course Programming for Problem Solving is offered by CSE Department and it is suggested to include standard text books like

1. Paul Deitel, Harvey Deitel, "C How To Program with an Introduction to C++", Global Edition (8e), Pearson Education, 2016.
2. Brian W. Kernighan and Dennis M. Ritchie "The C Programming Language", Prentice Hall, 1998.

Item 5: To suggest a programming subject, Object Oriented Programming through C++ or Python and approve the syllabus in Semester - I of B.E. (IT).

- CBIT Principal accepted to introduce one core programming course in place of basic Electrical Engineering course (theory and lab) for CSE / IT, in the meeting of Deans, Heads of the departments / Sections and Chairpersons of BoS of all departments held on 09-03-2018. Basic Electrical Engineering course (theory and lab) will be moved to Semester – III.

Hence, the committee thoroughly discussed in detail, both the programming courses, Object Oriented Programming with C++ and Python Programming and finally approved Object Oriented Programming through C++ as Python Programming is not covering all the object oriented concepts. The committee also approved syllabus for Object Oriented Programming through C++ (theory and lab).

The proposed scheme of syllabus for M.Tech. (CNIS) program is approved with following suggestions:

Presentation:

During the event Mr. Mr. Vihar Kurama addressed that Agile development – or simply Agile – is an iterative approach to software development that emphasizes flexibility, interactivity, and a high level of transparency.

Agile projects involve the frequent release of usable code, continuous testing (quality), and acceptance that whatever you think you know now, it'll change (reality!). With a few tweaks and some basic understanding of best practices, you can turn GitHub into a powerful Agile platform...and reap the sweet, sweet benefits of the GitHub data your team is already creating. GitHub reinvented what it means to collaborate on code. They championed a new era of open source development, which naturally transitioned into a profitable business driven from the ground up by developers who love the platform.

If something has code, there's a good chance it was developed or refined on GitHub. It's where the world's top software teams write, collaborate on, and ship amazing products. As GitHub took over the development world, project management companies rushed to integrate with it in an attempt to bridge management and development teams. But every solution shared the same problem.

They all “live” outside GitHub, forcing developers to jump from tool to tool to update tasks, tickets, and reports. The result is “context switching”, and it's much more costly than we expect. What people need is project management for GitHub, rather than a multitude of different tools in a million different places. Mr.A.Mohan, Asst Prof delivered the vote of thanks. During the event Mr. Mr. Vihar Kurama addressed that Data visualization may be described as graphically representing data. It is the act of translating data into a visual context, which can be done using charts, plots, animations, infographics, etc. The idea behind it is to make it easier for us (humans) to identify trends, outliers, and patterns in data. Data professionals regularly leverage data visualizations to summarize key insights from data and relay that information back to the appropriate stakeholders.

For example, a data professional may create data visualizations for management personnel, who then leverage those visualizations to project the organizational structure. Another example is when data scientists use visualizations to uncover the underlying structure of the data to provide them with a better understanding of their data. Data scientists are required to have a good understanding of the data they use. Data visualization makes it possible for data scientists to bring out the most informative aspects of their data, making it quick and easy for them (and others) to grasp what is happening in the data. For example, identifying trends in a dataset represented in a table format is much more complicated than seeing it visually. We will talk more about this in the common graphs used for data visualization section. Mr.A.Mohan, Asst Prof delivered the vote of thanks.
