INSTITUTE'S SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

CBIT is a self-financing institution. Despite this, the institute always strives hard to support its needy and deserving students, monetarily also. Over and above the scholarships disbursed by the State Government to the eligible students, the institute extends scholarships to a Considerable number among the left over. Such scholarships include both UG and PG students.

For UG students, the institute adjusts Rs.86, 500/- per student per year from the fee charged per NRI student per year (USD 5000). Such students will be about 400 per year. For PG students, all those who joined through GATE, will be given RS. 5000/- In addition to these, identified students will be given limited scholarships, by the institute.

Institute also facilitates scholarships through Alumni, to the needy and deserving students, who are selected though a Scrutiny Committee constituted by the alumni.

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GUIDELINES FOR PG SCHOLARSHIP

1. It will be obligatory for every post-graduate student who draws scholarship to undertake 8 to 10 hours (per week) of work related to teaching and research activities as assigned to him / her by the Institute. This could include tutorials, laboratory classes, development and maintenance of laboratories, assistance in research and development activities undertaken by faculty members, maintenance and operation of Computers and other central facilities, assistance in library, etc.
2. The Scholarship will be granted to the student on half yearly basis subject to the satisfactory academic performance such as having any backlogs and not involving in any academic misconduct and adherence to CBIT norms/rules and regulations as applicable from time to time, certified by the Head of the Department and any completion obligatory work as per item (1) above.
3. The student shall be required to give an undertaking to the effect that he / she would not leave the course midway. In case any student leaves the course in midway he/she will be required to refund the total PG Scholarship drawn at the time of leaving the course.
4. The CBIT may impose any other conditions as deemed necessary from time to time and the decision of the CBIT shall be final and binding upon the students who are under the ambit of the CBIT for receipt of PG Scholarship.
5. Students should maintain 75% attendance on monthly basis in each subject/Laboratory/Seminar/Project for getting eligibility for scholarship.
6. Scholarship will be granted based on the recommendation of concerned Head of the department followed by approval from Principal.




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
