



## **Career Development Centre Guidelines**

- 1. It is mandatory for the prefinal year students to give their career choices like placement, higher education, entrepreneurship, etc. in the prescribed proforma available on the website.
- Student shall participate in all the relevant events organised by CDC with discipline and commitment.
- Students shall not possess backlog history and maintain excellent academic grades consistently. Students shall not possess active backlogs and maintain a minimum of 6.5 CGPA before the beginning of final Year.
- 4. Students shall complete at least two Industry approved certifications in latest technologies before the beginning of final Year.
- 5. Students shall participate atleast in two hackathons before the beginning of final Year.
- 6. Students shall participate at least in two coding competitions before the beginning of final Year.
- 7. Students shall complete two capstone projects in their specialisation beyond the curriculum before the beginning of final year.
- 8. Students aspiring placements in Core sector shall clear GATE examination with good rank.
- All circuit branch students shall build their coding profile from III Semester onwards on platforms like Leetcode, Code forces, Code chef, Hacker rank, etc.
- 10. Students shall check the career pages of fortune companies to know the required skills for super dream placements.
- 11. Students shall maintain digital profile in professional networking platforms like LinkedIn from the day of joining the CBIT.
- 12. Students interested in Higher Education shall meet counselling teams available in the campus as per the notified dates.
- 13. Students aspiring to be entrepreneurs shall connect with Innovation and Incubation Cell (IIC), Research and Entrepreneurship (R&E), Atal Community Innovation Center (ACIC) in the campus.
- 14. Students who secured placements off campus are instructed to submit proof of their placement to respective Department Faculty Placement Coordinators.
