




Event Report Youth Parliament - CBITMUN 26th November 2022

We, the team of CBITMUN conducted **Youth Parliament** on the **26th of November**, **2022** on the occasion of **Constitution Day**. The occasion was graced by the presence of Dr. P Ravinder Reddy sir, Principal, and Prof P Sreenivasa Sarma sir, Advisor - Student Affairs and Progression. The topic of discussion was - The need for the Uniform Civil **Code-formulation of one nation, one law**. The agenda was chosen in coherence with the current national political scenario. Harsh Agarwal, Sohan Kumar, and Eswar **Teja Chava**, all three of them being alumni of CBIT, served as the Executive Board for the Youth Parliament. The event saw the footfall of over **130 delegates**, with their portfolios distributed over the entire political spectrum of the Indian Parliament. The day started with a training session, in which the Executive Board briefed the participants on the rule of procedures and about the takeaways of such a simulation. Owing to a large number of participants, two sessions of Youth Parliament were conducted- one in the ECE seminar hall and the other in Mechanical Seminar Hall. The sessions started off with the ruling party, defending the idea of having a uniform civil code- by which every citizen would be governed by a single law.






The opposition then went on to reaffirm its faith in the constitution's secular principles. Heated debate supplemented with intellect and continuing references to the principles of the Constitution followed

CBITMUN club was started in 2011 by a group of debate enthusiasts with the motto to set up, encourage, and endorse Model United Nations Conferences in Hyderabad. It was a Model UN Initiative for the first time at its level in the city of Hyderabad.


For over eleven years now, CBITMUN has not only succeeded in conducting world-class conferences every year but has been upholding traditions and delivering indelible imprints by orchestrating the Model UN culture in the entirety of Southern India.

The **12th edition** of the CBITMUN conference was held on the **28th**, **29th and 30th of April 2023** at **Sheraton**, **Financial District** with the tagline of the conference being **"परिवर्तनमेव स्थिरमस्ति"**. **Jeevanlal Lavidiya**, **IRS (IT)**, **Commissioner of Income Tax** graced the inaugural session as the **Chief Guest**. UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY _-Special Political and Decolonization Committee (UNGA - SPECPOL)

Supreme Soviet of the Soviet Union (SSSU)

The Supreme Soviet of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics was, beginning in 1936, the most authoritative legislative body of the USSR, and the only one with the power to approve constitutional amendments. The Supreme Soviet was composed of two chambers, each with equal legislative powers, with members elected for four-year terms. The committee consists of more than 20 delegates representing different portfolios of the soviet era.










UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL (UNSC)

The UN Security Council was the most technical committee that was simulated at CBITMUN 2023. The committee witnessed discussions on the ongoing Russia-Ukraine Conflict and solutions to the crisis were chalked out. The 20 delegates passed real-life resolutions outlining the solutions to the crisis at hand.

United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC)

The United Nation Human Rights Council (UNHRC) consists of 47 member states deliberating on human rights violation and protecting them. The committee debated on the women rights, challenges faced by them all across the world, and addressed every key issue. The committee witnessed the voices of more than 40 nations.







European Union (EU)

The European Union (EU) is a political and economic alliance of 27 countries. The EU promotes democratic values in its member nations and is one of the world's most powerful trade blocs. It operates an internal market which allows free movement of goods, capital, services and people between member states. The members of EU has deliberated upon the energy crisis in the Schengen region and come to a common consensus to solve the issue in hand.




Team CBITMUN 2023






ABOUT THE EVENT

ABOUT THE EVENT
