Minutes	:	<p>Director-Academics projected Standard Operation Procedure for UG MOOCS based tutorial courses in R-22 BE/B.Tech. Programs. It is observed from the deliberations that the MOOCS based tutorial courses are only for UG- B.E. CSE program and Committee members noted the same.</p>
Item No: 11	:	Review on syllabus coverage for I, III, V & VII Semesters
Minutes	:	<p>Director-Academics appraised that the syllabus coverage should be in conformity with the lesson plan. Principal and the Director-Academics informed the Heads that many faculty are not writing Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) in the laboratory registers and few faculty are not updating the registers regularly. In this regard, Principal instructed the Heads to verify the registers periodically and counsel the staff if needed.</p> <p>Principal informed the Committee members that the Syllabus Coverage reports can be submitted once in a fortnight.</p>

Internship Policy

As per the AICTE Internship policy Guidelines & Procedures (April 2019), CBIT implementing internship in R-20, R-22, and R-22A mandatorily. The regulations are applicable to the students who joined from the Academic Year 2020-21 onwards. The following framework is proposed is approved in the Academic Council to give academic credits for the internships undergone as a part of B.E/B.Tech programme under the regulations of both R-20, R-22, and R-22A.

Every student has to undergo a minimum of **THREE** Internship programmes during their study of B.E/B.Tech Degree program under R-20 and R-22. The number of internships carried out was further modified to a minimum of **TWO** Internship programmes under R-22A regulations the details of which are shown in the tabular form below.

The internship programs may include the activities of Industrial Training/Govt./NGO/MSME/Rural Internship/Innovation/Entrepreneurship/National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF) level 3 to 5 and Intra/Inter institutional training or workshop. The credits earned shall be considered for the award of degree. To each one (1) credit, student has to put up 40 to 45 hours of work i.e., full-time intern is expected to spend 45 hours per week on Internship, Training, Project work, Seminar activities etc. Internship may be full-time or part-time. It may be full-time during the summer/winter vacation and part-time during the academic session. Internship schedules shall be notified by the institution time to time. In addition to internship the Mini project and Upskilling certification courses have been added in place of Internship – III under R-22 A. The Internship duration and academic credit requirements are given as follows:
