#### **Minutes:**

To approve the minutes of PAQIC Meeting 2024:

Chairman, PAQIC BE (ECE), presented the minutes of PAQIC Meeting 2024. The members approved the same.

2. Development of Curriculum of R-22A Regulation:

Chairman outlined the details of R-22A curriculum of UG (B.E (ECE)) and informed the committee that the syllabus is being proposed for UG (B.E(Electronics Engineering)- VLSID) for V and VI Semesters. Dr G. Prasad inquired about the elective courses and basis of their selection. Chairman addressed that the electives are selected based on Industry related issues and needs of students.

# 3. Quality of Question papers and assignments:

Dr. G. Prasad commented on question papers synchronism.

 Chairman discussed about the quality of question paper and presented the quality of Question papers of two courses that recorded less pass percentage. He added about the selection of question paper setters from IITs and NITs.

Mr. Ajay said that, the pattern of the question paper is based on the course.

 Prof. N.V. Koteswara Rao addressed the same by discussing the % of weightage in the question paper.

4. Result Analysis and action taken

The results of AY 2024 batch are discussed. Chairman has informed that the pass percentage of II Semester Courses "Signals and Systems (22ECC04)" and "Network Analysis and Synthesis (22ECC03)" is less and the remedial measures are being taken. Also, he informed that more solved examples are being given to students in terms of handouts and videos Dr. G. Prasad asked about 2023 batch results.

Chairman has shown the results of that batch

5. CO-PO-PSO Attainments – fixing targets

Chairman submitted that as per the new NBA guidelines, the program outcomes are reduced to 11. In this connection, Prof. N.V. Koteswara Rao addressed that two old POs are now combined and hence the number is now 11.

Further, he said that accordingly the articulation matrices will be modified. Chairman requested the committee to increase the target level by 2%. The committee members have given approval for the same.

6. Winter Upskilling Certifications, Internships, Industrial Visits

Chairman presented the details of the initiatives like internship and Winter upskilling and their impact on placements. He also quoted examples of students who could get good placements based on the winter upskilling certifications.

7. Initiation of Department News Letter:

Dr. G. Prasad asked whether our department newsletter is subset of college newsletter? Chairman has informed the committee about the newly proposed department news letter "News Taranga". Chairman clarified that the department newsletter is not a subset of college newsletter.

8. Faculty contributions and competencies improved

Committee suggested to improve the number of quality publications and also to improve the faculty participation in training programs/ workshops organized by primier institutions such as IITs, NITs and IIITs.

9. Department Infrastructure Facilities, MoU's and Student Support System

Chairman informed the committee that the department has entered into an MoU with Pi Square Technologies. He stated that the MoU aims to advance embedded systems and automotive software education by fostering research, training, and industry collaboration. Soon a CoE will be established as part of the MoU.

# 10. Placements, Higher studies and Entrepreneurship:

Chairman presented the Placements, Higher studies and Entrepreneurship details. Dr. G. Prasad asked about the number of placements in Government organizations Chairman has presented the details of placements especially in Government organizations.

### 11. Student Achievements

Chairman presented the details of student participation in various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

## 12. Any other item

Chairman has informed the committee that the department is aligned towards United Nation's Sustainable development goals and is focusing on integrating the 17 goals into its activities.

Chairman informed the committee about the proposal of allowing final year B.E. (ECE) students to pursue their entire final year (VII and VIII Semesters) at VEDA IIT, Hyderabad. He informed the committee that the list of equivalent courses offered at VEDA IIT and their corresponding CBIT R22 courses are prepared.

Chairman informed the committee that the Vision, Mission, PEOs, PSOs of B.E (Electronics Engineering (VLSI Design and Technology) are being framed in line with Institute's Vision and Mission.

The committee members appreciated the chairman for the detailed presentation of every aspect and the efforts of the department. The meeting ended with formal vote of thanks by the convener.
