The meeting commenced with welcoming by the Chairman, PAQIC of BE-ECE & EVL.

Minutes:


1.	To approve the minutes of PAQIC Meeting 2025: Chairman, PAQIC BE (ECE & EVL), presented the minutes of PAQIC Meeting 2025. The members approved the same. The Committee approved the Minutes of PAQIC meeting 2025.
2.	Teaching Learning process (TLP improvement) Chairman outlined the details of the Teaching Learning process including innovative teaching methodology, Quality of question papers, CIE, Result Analysis, Remedial classes and outcomes. The members appreciated the efforts of the department towards continuous improvement in TLP, especially the remedial classes and their outcomes.
3.	Innovations in Curriculum A comprehensive comparison of R22A and R26 curriculum is provided. The scheme of UG programs (BE (ECE) and BE (EVL)) and the syllabus of the courses offered by ECE Board in first and second semesters is presented. The members insisted to add foundation courses on AI. The Committee agreed to place the curriculum to the BOS Committee for further actions.
4.	Student Projects and outcomes An overview of the student project's allocation process, continuous monitoring and outcomes produced is provided. The committee commended the students' inclination towards producing project outcomes. Sri. K. Pramod appreciated the outcomes from projects, especially the publications and patent. Dr.Venkatesh Narasimhan appreciated the students' exposure to productizing their ideas and informed that their company would be happy to guide and assist them in the productization process. The Committee also agreed for the formats presented for Project review for continuous improvement
5.	Student support system Chairman briefed about how student mentoring plays a vital role in the student support system in terms of guidance, motivation, and personalized assistance for academic and personal growth. Sri. B. Sumanth Reddy suggested inculcating students' interest in their chosen field from the early semesters of their studies.
6.	Faculty contribution and progress The details of faculty achievements in terms of awards, programs organized by faculty, programs attended by faculty are presented. The committee appreciated the faculty continuous commitment to academic and professional excellence.
7.	Industry Interaction & Skill Development The activities carried out by the department in collaboration with industry in terms of industry visits, expert talks, MoUs, upskilling courses are presented. Sri. K. Pramod informed that this interaction is the need of the hour due to growing demand for Electronics and communication graduates in areas of Quantum technologies/AI Chipsets/Embedded Systems/VLSI/Chip design/IoT hardware etc.
8.	Placement, Higher studies and Entrepreneurship An analysis of the student's Placements, Higher studies and Entrepreneurship is presented. Sri. Shravan commended the increase in number of students going for higher studies. Sri .K .Pramod added that this number may come down in next year due to the hostile situations existing overseas and suggested students to always have an alternative career option.
9.	Research and Development A detailed analysis of Faculty publications, student publications, sponsored research and consultancy projects, seed money grants is presented. The Committee was happy with the department progress in Research and Development for A y 2025-26
10.	Dept. Infrastructure The details of industry supported laboratories and Centre of Excellence are presented. The committee recognized them as valuable initiatives that enhance practical learning, industry exposure, and skill development among students.
